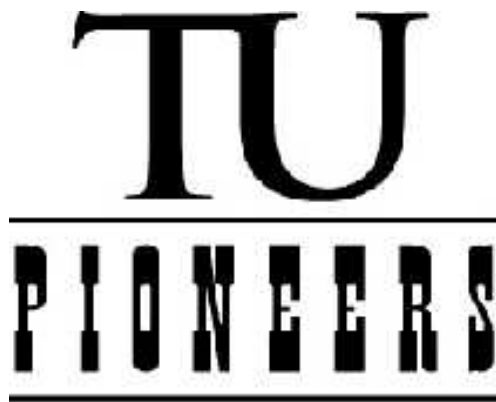

DIRECTIONS TO TRANSYLVANIA

From the North and West (Cincinnati, Louisville)

Follow I-64 East or I-75 South. These interstates merge; take the Lexington-Paris exit (Exit 113). From the ramp, turn right on North Broadway. Follow North Broadway to Fourth Street. Transylvania is between Fourth and Third streets.

From the East and South (Knoxville, Huntington, W.Va.)

Follow I-64 West or I-75 North. These interstates merge; take the Lexington-Paris exit (Exit 113). From the ramp, turn right on North Broadway. Follow North Broadway to Fourth Street. Transylvania is between Fourth and Third streets.

From the Southwest (Nashville)

Follow I-65 North to Elizabethtown; exit at the Bluegrass Parkway. This merges with Versailles Road (U.S. 60) about 10 miles west of Lexington. Take U.S. 60 to downtown Lexington. After this street becomes one way, turn left on Broadway; go seven blocks to Third Street. Transylvania is between Third and Fourth Streets.
