SAFETY AND SECURITY

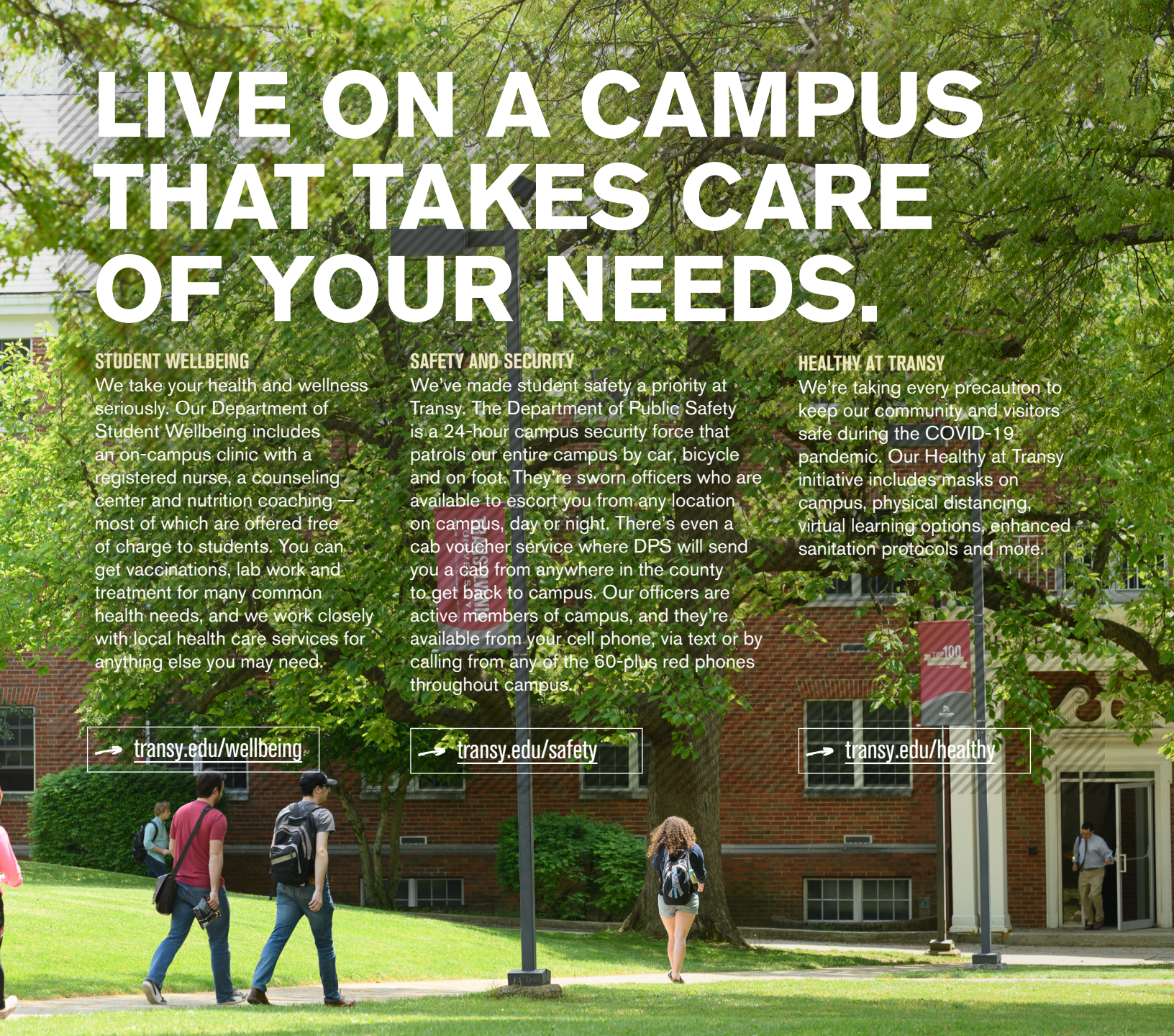

1 | SCHEDULE YOUR CAMPUS VISIT

A campus visit to Transylvania is the most important step in the college search process. We have lots of different visit options to fit your schedule. 4 | RECEIVE YOUR FINANCIAL AID OFFER

Once you're admitted and submit the FAFSA, you'll get your financial aid offer from Transy! It will include a detailed estimate of all the institutional, federal and state aid that will be provided to you and your family.

Tip: Your package will include an estimated total out-of-pocket cost to attend Transy — that's much more important than the sticker price.

2 | APPLY

Go to transy.edu/apply to submit your application. Apply by one of our Early Action deadlines to be considered for our Premier Scholarships. We also accept the Common Application.

Tip: We're a test-optional school, so you don't need to include your ACT or SAT scores if you don't feel they're an accurate representation of your abilities.

5 | SUBMIT YOUR DEPOSIT

Your \$350 nonrefundable deposit will secure your spot at Transylvania. Make sure you take advantage of every opportunity to compare Transy against your other college options. Contact us anytime to help.

3 | FILL OUT THE FAFSA

To be considered for need-based financial aid, all you need to do is fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid at fafsa.gov. It's recommended for any student seeking federal or state aid (including grants, loans and work-study).
