		be given the option to link your Federal PIN to your FSA ID during the setup process. If possible,
		you should link your PIN so that you can begin using your FSA ID right away. If you are not able
		to link you PIN, you may have to wait 1-3 days after creating your FSA ID to complete the steps
		above.

Exit counseling Accounting Office sends emails regarding exit counseling and also gives graduating and withdrawing students a packet of information regarding exit counseling and loan repayment and all information regarding their loans. Packets are mailed to students if not picked

up.

Exit Counseling Example

"Dear Class of 2015,

Congratulations on your upcoming graduation in May. While attending Transylvania you borrowed from the student loan program, therefore it is **mandatory** that you complete online Senior Loan Counseling. Those who have not completed by **May 5**th will have a **hold** placed on their **diploma**. Please complete the following tasks by **as soon as possible**:

- 1. Federal Perkins Loan counseling website: http://www.heartlandecsi.com/. Transylvania University uses ECSI for all Perkins loans processing and billing.
- Federal Direct Loan counseling website: https://studentloans.gov/myDirectLoan/index.action. Click Sign In button, sign in, then click Complete Counseling, Exit Counseling to complete your session.
- 3. Elect to receive your 1098T electronically via <u>TNet</u>. Please log in and select the 1098T Electronic Consent.
- 4. Updated email address with Transylvania at http://www.transy.edu/alumni/tnet_form.htm. This will ensure you are able to reset your password for TNet if you were to forget it. Your TNet access will remain upon graduation.

Items you will need in order to complete loan counseling:

- FAFSA
- Driver's license
- Future employer (if applicable)
- Three personal references, including address and phone number (These references should be the name of someone who would know how to contact you and must live at a difference address and cannot be your parents.)

The purpose of this counseling is to provide you with information concerning your rights and responsibilities, as well as help you be better equipped to make good, sound decisions about managing your money and financial obligations.

		 Neither Transylvania as an institution nor any individual officer, employee or agent shall enter into any revenue-sharing arrangements with any lender.

No officer or employee of Transylvania who is employed in the financial aid office or who otherwise has responsibilities with respect to education loans, or agent who has responsibilities with respect to education loans, or any of their family members, shall solicit or accept any gift from a lender, guarantor, or servicer of education loans. For purposes of this prohibition, the term "gift" means any gratuity, favor, discount, entertainment, hospitality, loan, or other item having a monetary value of more than a de minimus amount.
		 An officer or employee of Transylvania who is employed in the financial aid office or who otherwise has responsibilities with respect to education loans, or an agent who has responsibilities with respect to education loans, shall not accept from any lender or affiliate of any lender any fee, payment, or other financial benefit (including the opportunity to purchase stock) as compensation for any type of consulting arrangement or other contract to provide services to a lender or on behalf of a lender relating to education loans. Transylvania shall not: for any first-time borrower, assign, through award packaging or other methods,

		the borrower's loan to a particular lender; or 2. refuse to certify, or delay certification of, any loan based on the borrower's selection of a particular lender or guaranty agency. 5. Transylvania shall not request or accept from any lender any offer of funds to be used for private education loans, including funds for an opportunity pool loan, to students in exchange for the institution providing concessions or promises regarding providing the lender with: 1. a specified number of loans made, insured, or guaranteed under Title IV; 2. a specified loan volume of such loans; or 3. a preferred lender arrangement for such loans. 6. Transylvania shall not request or accept from any lender any assistance with call center staffing or financial aid office staffing. 7. Any employee who is employed in the financial aid office, or who otherwise has responsibilities with respect to education loans or other student financial aid, and who serves on an advisory board, commission, or group established by a lender, guarantor, or group of lenders or guarantors, shall be prohibited from receiving anything of value from the lender, guarantor, or group of lenders or guarantors, except that the employee may be reimbursed for reasonable expenses incurred in serving on such advisory board, commission, or group.
