Go to www.studentLoans.gov, log in, and choose Complete Counseling to begin. Master Promissory Note (MPN): The MPN is a legally binding agreement stating that you promise to repay the loan with interest. Also at www.studentLoans.gov, log in and choose Complete a Master Promissory Note. As of May 10, 2015, you need an FSA ID instead of a PIN to log in to all Federal Student Aid websites. If you have not yet created your FSA ID, you can do so at www.studentLoans.gov, You will be given the option to link your Federal PIN to your FSA ID during the setup process. If possible, you should link your PIN so that you can begin using your FSA ID right away. If you are not able to link you PIN, you may have to wait 1-3 days after creating your FSA ID to complete the steps above.

		2. No officer or employee of Transylvania who is employed in the financial aid office or who
		otherwise has responsibilities with respect to education loans, or agent who has
		responsibilities with respect to education loans, or any of their family members, shall
		solicit or accept any gift from a lender, guarantor, or servicer of education loans. For
		purposes of this prohibition, the term "gift" means any gratuity, favor, discount,
		entertainment, hospitality, loan, or other item having a monetary value of more than a
		de minimus amount.
		3. An officer or employee of Transylvania who is employed in the financial aid office or who otherwise has responsibilities with respect to education loans, or an agent who has
		responsibilities with respect to education loans, shall not accept from any lender or
		affiliate of any lender any fee, payment, or other financial benefit (including the
		opportunity to purchase stock) as compensation for any type of consulting arrangement
		or other contract to provide services to a lender or on behalf of a lender relating to
		education loans.

		 4. Transylvania shall not: a) for any first-time borrower, assign, through award packaging or other methods, the borrower's loan to a particular lender; or b) refuse to certify, or delay certification of, any loan based on the borrower's selection of a particular lender or guaranty agency.
		5. Transylvania shall not request or accept from any lender any offer of funds to be used for private education loans, including funds for an opportunity pool loan, to students in exchange for the institution providing concessions or promises regarding providing the lender with:
		 a) a specified number of loans made, insured, or guaranteed under Title IV; b) a specified loan volume of such loans; or c) a preferred lender arrangement for such loans.
		 Transylvania shall not request or accept from any lender any assistance with call center staffing or financial aid office staffing.
		7. Any employee who is employed in the financial aid office, or who otherwise has responsibilities with respect to education loans or other student financial aid, and who serves on an advisory board, commission, or group established by a lender, guarantor, or group of lenders or guarantors, shall be prohibited from receiving anything of value from the lender, guarantor, or group of lenders or guarantor, or guarantors, except that the employee may be reimbursed for reasonable expenses incurred in serving on such advisory board, commission, or group.
