

Glen S. Bagby graduated from Transy in 1966. He began his law practice in Lexington in 1969. Since 2009, he has practiced with Dinsmore & Shohl LLP. He has been selected for *Best Lawyers in America* in three areas of practice, in *Trusts and Estates*, *Family Law* and *Trusts and Estates – Litigation*. In 2014, the *Best Lawyers in America* publication named him Lawyer of the Year in Kentucky for *Trusts and Estates* law practice. Since 2006, Bagby has served on the board of trustees of Transylvania University. He has served as Chair of the Finance Committee of the board of trustees since 2015. In 2017, he was recognized with Transylvania's Morrison Medallion.

Since 2009, he has taught the Advanced Estate Planning course at the College of Law at the University of Kentucky as an adjunct professor each spring semester for up to sixteen graduating law school seniors.
